A RING EITHER IN THE OFFICE IN THE DAYTIME OR WISCONSIN FOUR TWO
FOUR SIX AT NIGHT AND WE WILL OUTLINE WITH YOU THE PROBLEM
THAT HAS BEEN ADVANCED TO US stop THING YOU BOTH SHOULD
CONSIDER IT stop ALSO IF YOU THINK THAT MR SHEA OF HARVARD LAW
SCHOOL ABOUT WHOM I SPOKE TO YOU MIGHT BE A GOOD MAN IN
CHARGE OF OUR RECORDS AND FILING I THINK THERE IS AN
OPPORTUNITY FOR HIM stop HAVE ASKED SHEA TO CONTACT YOU stop
SHEA AS YOU REMEMBER IS NOW CONNECTED WITH THE SUPREME
