Proposed Bill Signing Ceremony for May 3

Attached is a memo from Ted Barreaux, Director of Congressional Relations, Securities and Exchange Commission, requesting that the President have a bill signing ceremony on Saturday, May 3 for the Securities Reform Act of 1975.
