To The Members Of The United States Senate -

Honorable Dear Sir:

We are very much disturbed and exercised over the most recent drastic urge of the President of the United States to make impotent the Judicial branch of our National Government.

We are convinced that these changes are being proposed at this time not for the purpose of strengthening the balance of power among the three separate branches of our Government, but for the ultimate purpose of undermining the fundamental principles which form the basis of our Constitution.

The Year Books of the Carnegie Endowments, the American Foundations and Fields, and the 20th Century Fund, Inc., (which latter thru interlocking directorates controls about 124 so-called American trust funds), are sufficient proof that these organizations have sponsored much of the revolutionary legislation and foreign policy which has been foisted upon the unsuspecting American people during the past four years. Most of this "must" legislation has been proven to be unconstitutional and detrimental to the fundamental liberties of the American people----liberties which have been so courageously preserved by the unprejudiced decisions of our present Supreme Court.

We do not propose to be regimented, socialized, communized or sovietized by this socalled "progressive" and "enabling" legislation. Likewise we do not submit to the propaganda that an alliance of the English-speaking nations of the world is the only possible way out of our present dilemma.

Our Constitution has been and is now a sufficient guarantee that those inalienable rights will be safeguarded which were purchased for us by our forefathers with their very life's blood. Under our present form of balanced government this nation has prospered and progressed to a place of enviable preeminence in the world. However, from 1776 until the present day we have never been free from the tinkering influences of Anglo-American Tories. We do not intend to be "shackled", particularly to an alien government.

You were sent to Congress to represent the American people, and not to take the dictation of <u>one man</u>. We therefore, being citizens of the United States of America, demand that you shall fulfill your oath of office, to uphold the Constitution of the United States as it <u>WAS</u> when you took that oath.

We rely on you in this great crisis!
