SUBJECT: Proposed Bill Signing
Ceremony for May 3

Attached is a memo from Ted Barreaux, Director of Congressional Relations, Securities and Exchange Commission, requesting that the President have a bill signing ceremony on Saturday, May 3 for the Securities Reform Act of 1975. There is urgency about getting the bill signed because of difficulties which trust departments of banks will have if certain protective features of the bill do not become effective as soon as possible.

I advised Ted Barreaux that the President would be departing at 10:00 a.m. for Norfolk on Saturday, but he urges that 15 minutes be set aside for the signing ceremony some time before the President's departure.

I would appreciate your giving this your prompt attention and advising me of what could be done.
